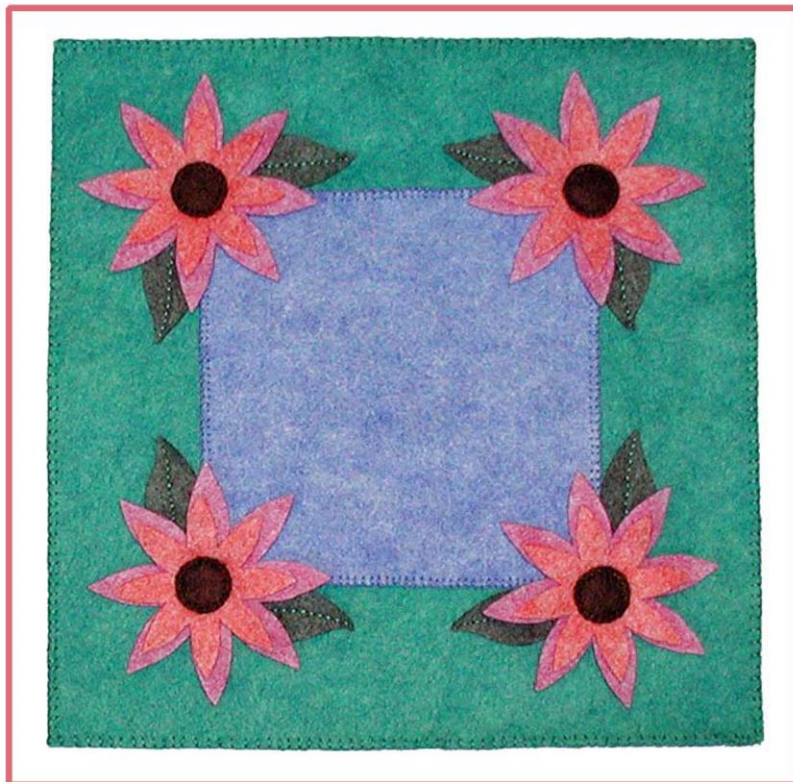

## Materials:

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- National Nonwovens WoolFelt Once Upon a Felt color series\*:
  - 12 ½" x 12 ½" piece Leaping Lizards
  - 7" x 7" piece Spellbound Sapphire
  - 10" x 10" piece Pixie Pink
  - 7" x 7" piece Charming Coral
  - 6" x 7" piece Forbidden Forest
  - 3" x 3" piece Bewitching Brown
  - 12 ½" x 12 ½" piece of any color for the back of the mat.

*\*The WoolFelt used in this project was not pre-washed. If you wish to use pre-washed WoolFelt, measure after washing.*

- DMC Six-Strand Embroidery Floss to match WoolFelt. Use three strands for all sewing:
  - 3816 for Leaping Lizards and Forbidden Forest
  - 3839 for Spellbound Sapphire
  - 433 for Bewitching Brown
  - No floss is needed for the other colors.
- Large-eyed chenille needle, straight pins, scissors, freezer paper, pen or pencil, glue stick (optional), ruler, rotary cutter, iron and pressing cloth.

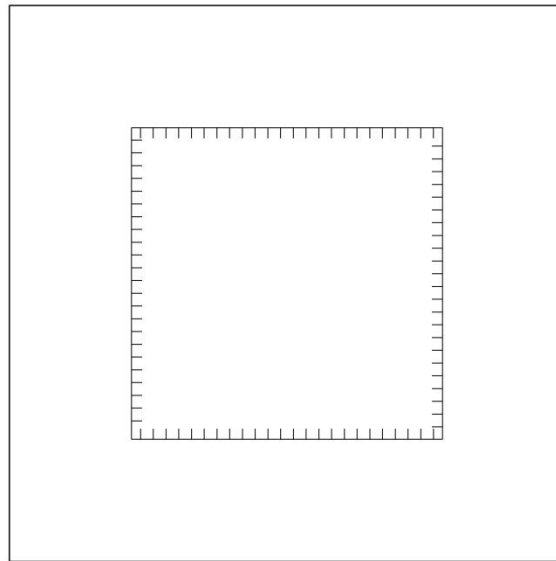
## Instructions:

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- Trace all pattern pieces onto freezer paper and cut out.
- To use the freezer paper templates, place them shiny side down on the WoolFelt. Set the iron to the wool setting with no steam; the iron must be dry. Iron the freezer paper onto the WoolFelt, pressing down for a few seconds until the freezer paper sticks.
- Cut the patterns from the WoolFelt in the following quantities:
  - From the Forbidden Forest WoolFelt, cut eight leaves.
  - From the Bewitching Brown WoolFelt, cut four flower centers.
  - From the Pixie Pink WoolFelt, cut four outer flowers.
  - From the Charming Coral WoolFelt, cut four inner flowers.
- If desired, use the glue stick to adhere smaller applique pieces before stitching.

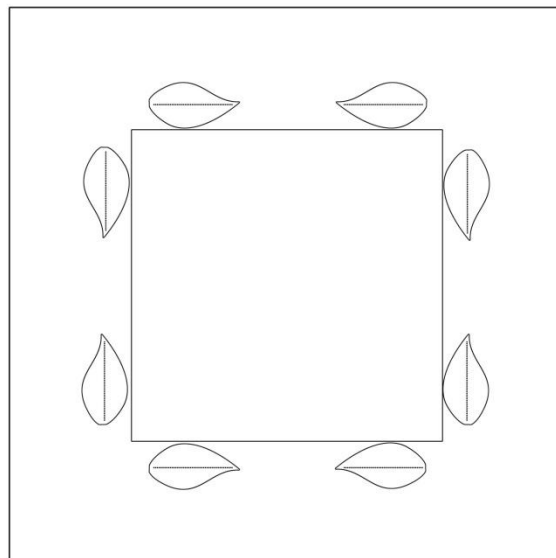
- Center the 7" Spellbound Sapphire square on the 12 ½" x 12 ½" Leaping Lizards square and pin. Sew with the 3839 floss and a blanket stitch. See Figure A.

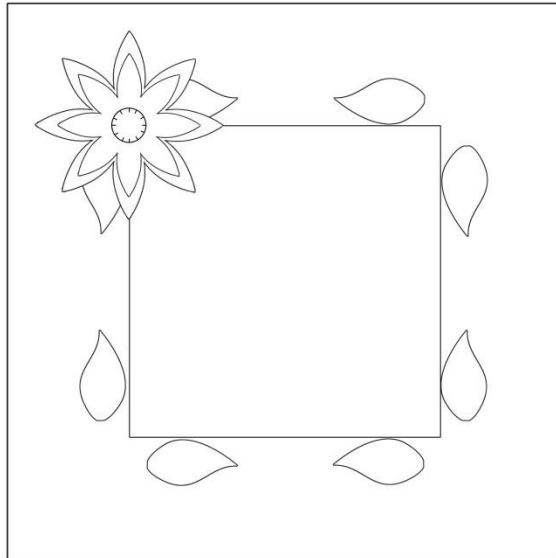
- Position the leaves as shown in Figure B. The ends of the leaves should be ½" from the corners of the 7" Spellbound Sapphire square. Pin or tack down with glue stick. Sew using the 3816 floss and a back stitch down the center of each leaf. See Figure B.

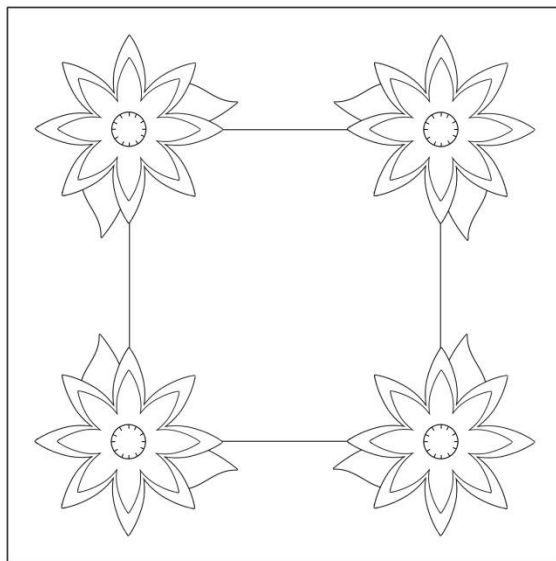
- Layer an outer flower, an inner flower, and flower center together. Pin down on the corner of the 7" Spellbound Sapphire square. With the 433 floss, blanket stitch around the flower center. See Figure C.

- Repeat for three other flowers as shown in Figure D.

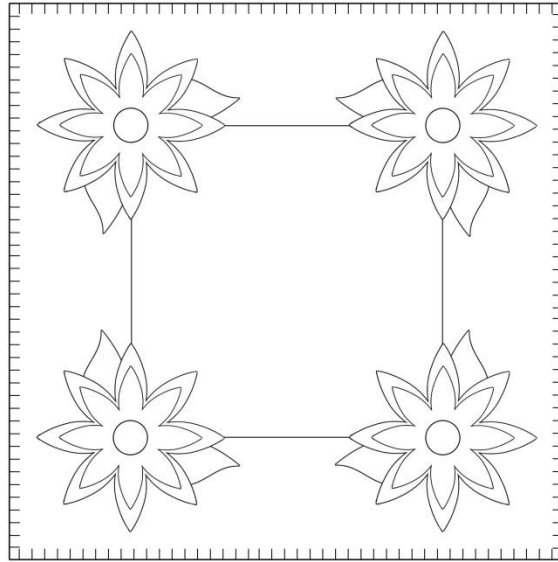

- Press with a warm iron on the wool setting and using a presser cloth.
- Pin the other 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" square (of any color) behind the finished top.

- Blanket stitch the two squares together with the 3816 floss as shown in Figure E.

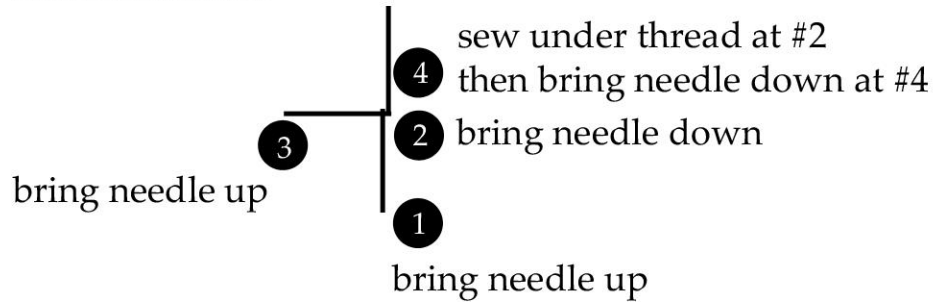


- Press again with a warm iron on the wool setting and using a presser cloth.
- Place on a table, add a candle, or a vase of flowers, and enjoy!

## Stitch Diagrams

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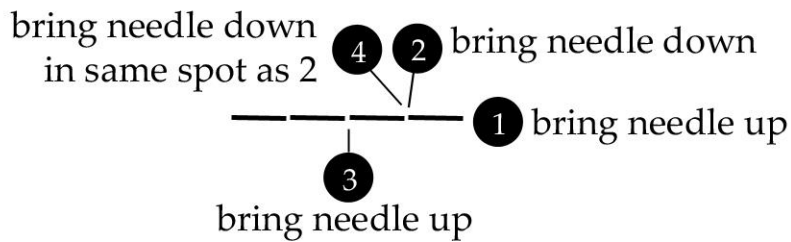
### Blanket Stitch
