

Jack O'Lantern Mug Rug



Foundation Paper Pieced and Appliqued Project
Finished size of mug rug is approximately 9" x 12"

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Materials:

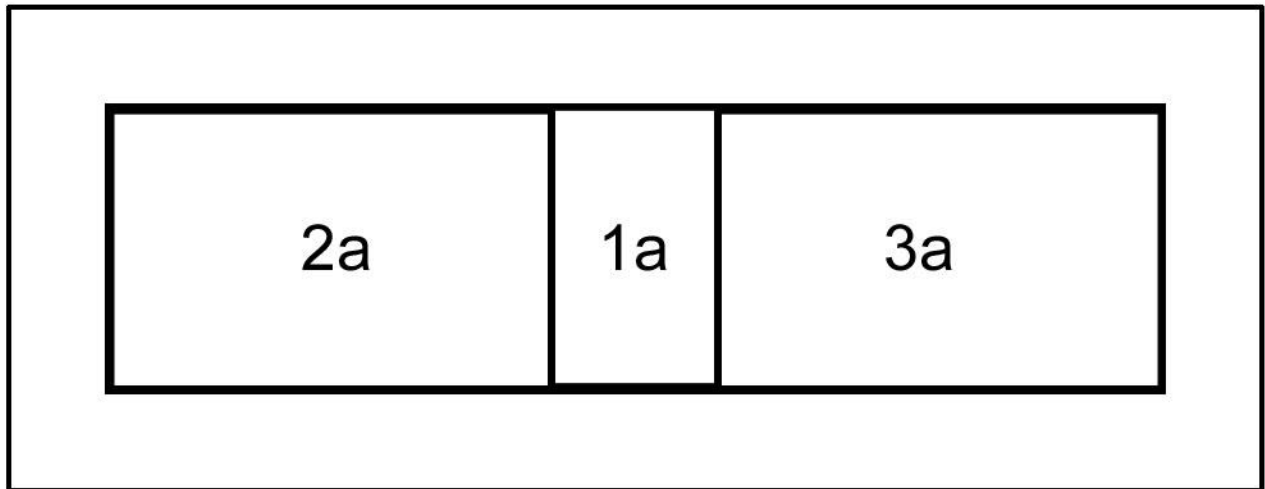
- Fabric scraps for piecing and appliqueing.
- Fusible web for applique.
- Embroidery floss and needle for hand appliqueing if desired.
- Sewing machine and standard sewing implements (pins, scissors, etc.)
- Batting and fabric for backing and binding.
(The amount of fabric needed depends upon your preferred method of backing & binding)

Instructions:

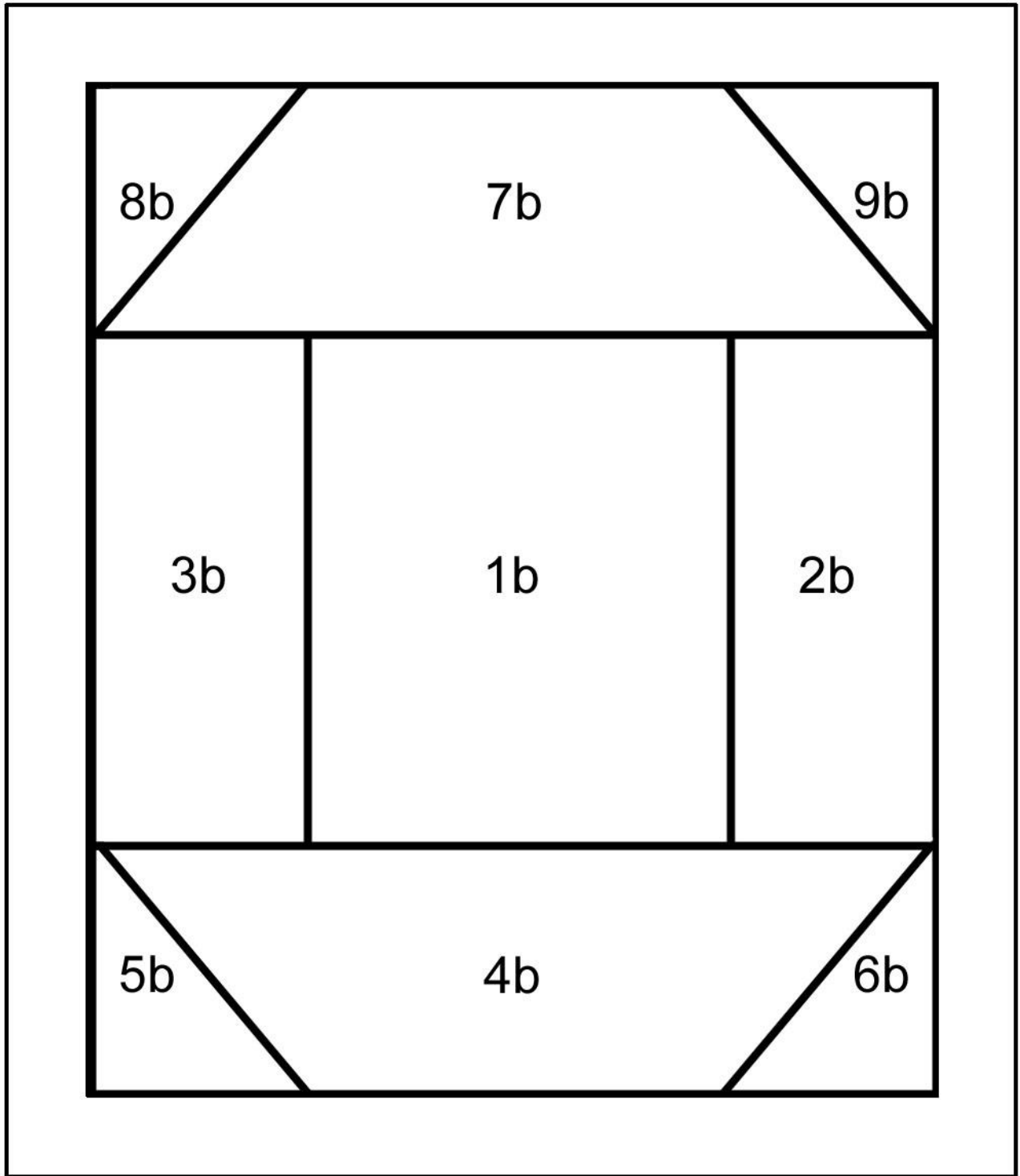
- Print out section pages. Do not trim pages until after piecing. The outer line is the final trim line.
- Piece Section 1; Trim on outside line; Set aside.
- Piece Section 2; Trim on outside line.
- Join Sections 1 & 2 with $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance
- Join pieced side with a 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9" piece fabric on right side with $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance.
- Print applique shapes on a printable fusible web sheet, or trace onto fusible web. Vine has already been reversed on the pattern.
- Apply fusible web to back side of fabric scraps for leaves and vines per manufacturer's instructions.
- Cut out applique shapes.
- Fuse to pieced mug rug as shown in diagram.
- Blanket stitch applique shapes, or stitch with preferred method.
- Quilt and bind mug rug as desired.
