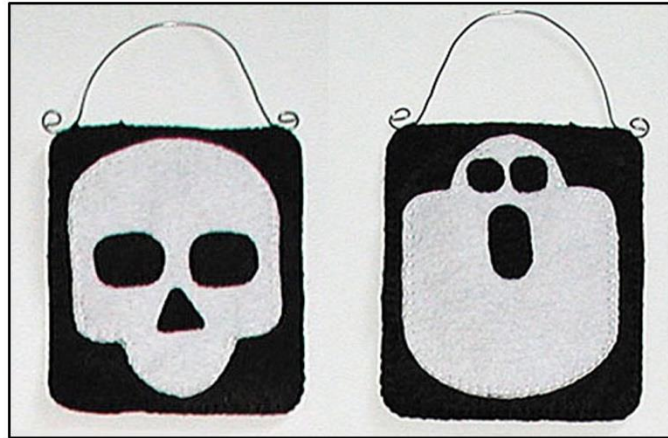


Skull/Ghost 2-sided WoolFelt Ornament

Materials:

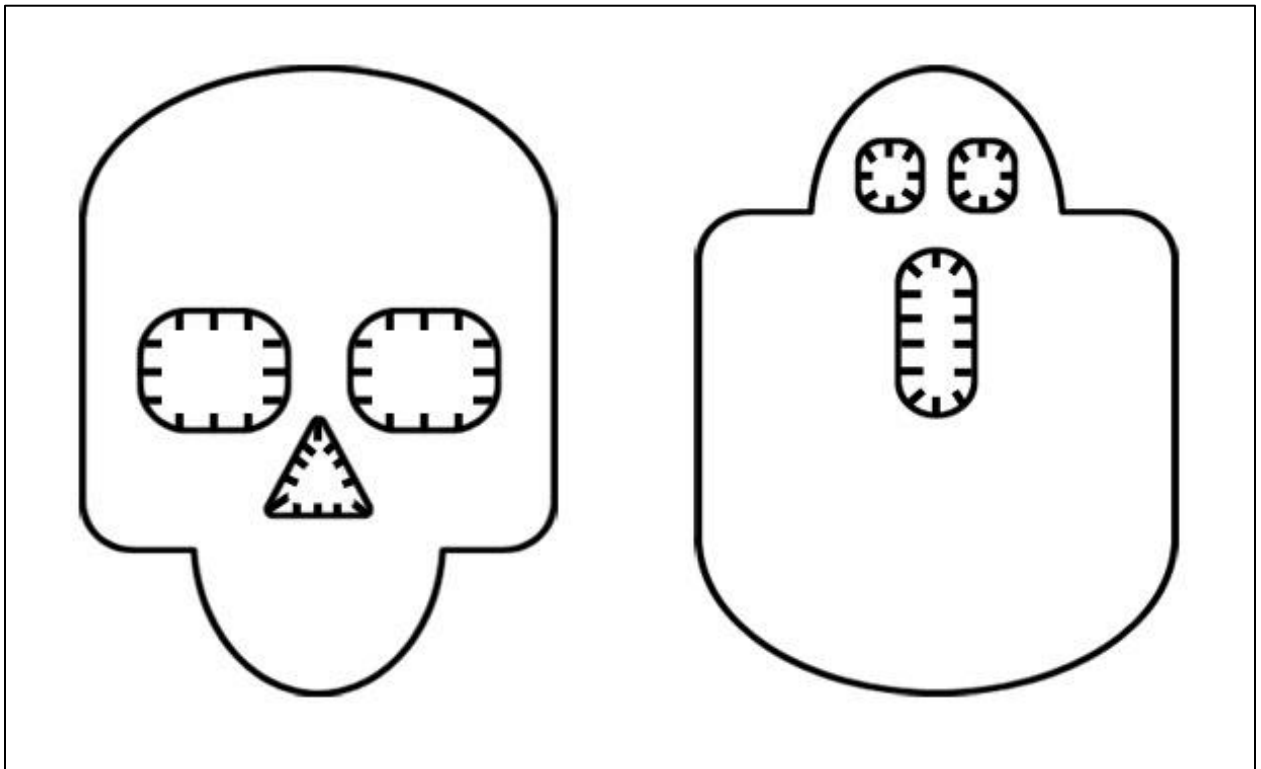
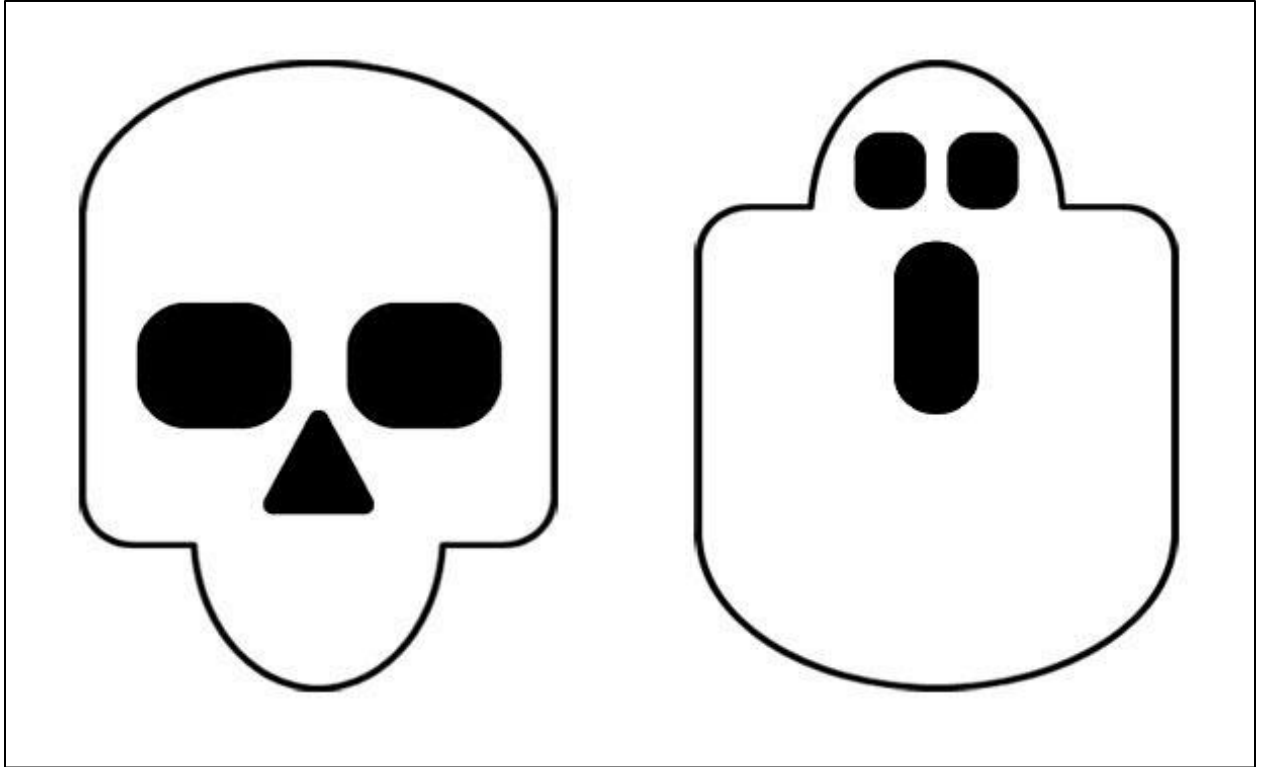
- National Nonwovens WoolFelt Scraps:
 - Two 4" x 5" pieces Antique White WoolFelt.
 - Two 4.5" x 5.5" pieces Black WoolFelt* plus scraps for faces.
- DMC Six-Strand Embroidery Floss (use three strands at a time):
 - 3865 (to match Antique White WoolFelt)
 - 310 (to match Black White WoolFelt)
- 8" piece 18 gauge wire (or other wire of your choice).
- Large-eyed chenille needle, straight pins, scissors, freezer paper, pen or pencil, glue stick, iron, wire cutting and bending tools.

*Note: The materials listed make one double-sided ornament. If you want to make two separate ornaments, you'll need four 4.5" x 5.5" pieces Black WoolFelt.

Instructions:

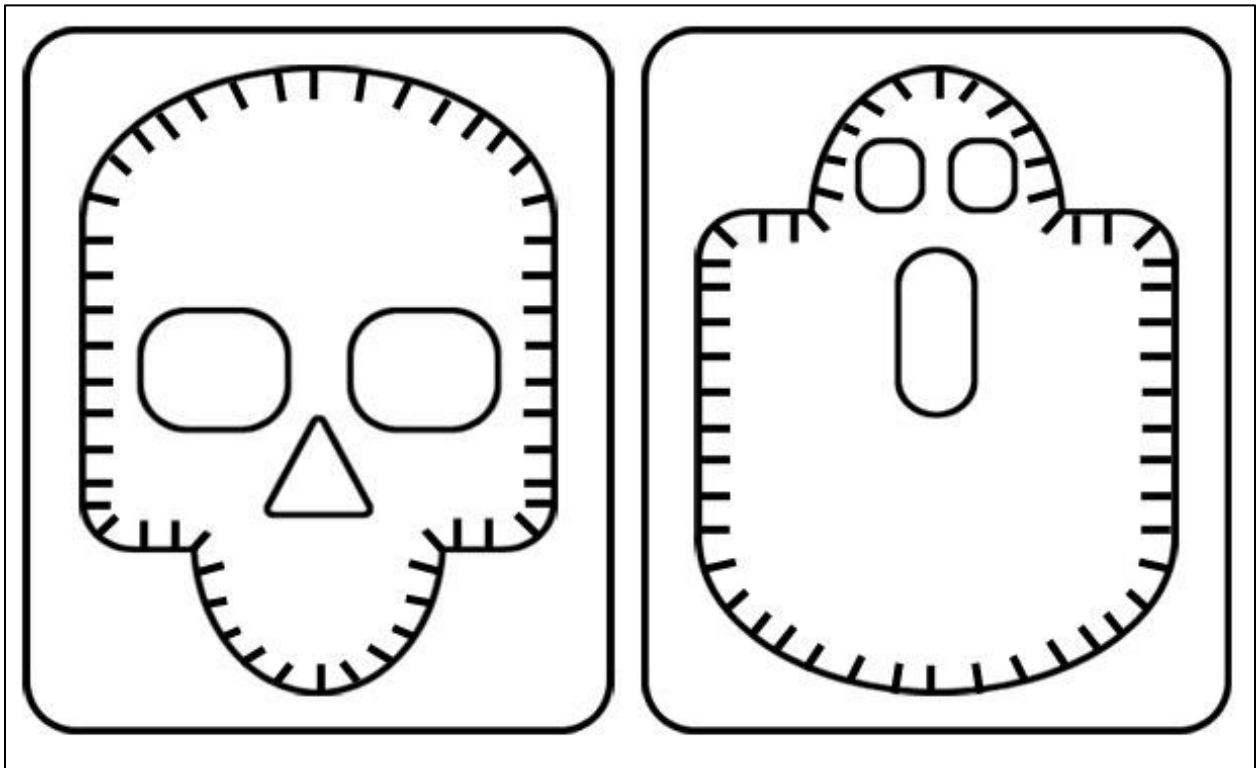
- Trace all pattern pieces onto freezer paper and cut out.
- To use the freezer paper templates, place them shiny side down on the WoolFelt. Set the iron to the wool setting with no steam; the iron must be dry. Iron the freezer paper onto the WoolFelt, pressing down for a few seconds until the freezer paper sticks.
- Cut the pattern pieces from the WoolFelt as follows:
 - Cut out the background pieces from the Black WoolFelt.
 - Cut out the face pieces from the Black WoolFelt scraps.
 - Cut out the skull and ghost shapes from the Antique White WoolFelt.
- Use the glue stick to adhere the face pieces to the skull and ghost before stitching. (See Figure A for position).
- Using the 310 floss, blanket stitch around each face part, as shown in Figure A.

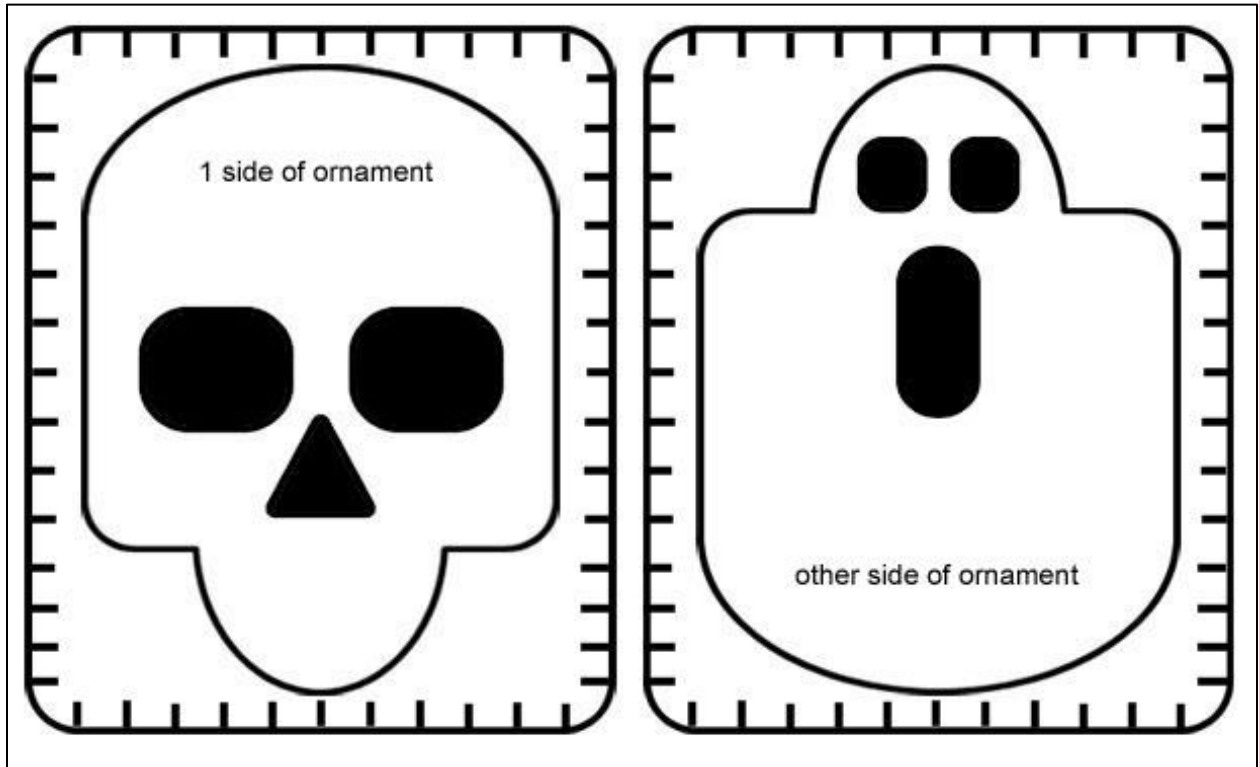
- Center the skull on one of the black backgrounds and pin in place, or tack with glue stick. Repeat for ghost and other black background. (See Figure B for position).
- Using the 3865 floss, blanket stitch the skull to the background piece, as shown in Figure B. Using the 3865 floss, blanket stitch the ghost to the background piece, as shown in Figure B.

- Pin the two ornaments, wrong sides together, and blanket stitch around edge with the 310 floss, as shown in Figure C.

- See Figures D & E to form hanger:
 - Bend the wire into an arc/hanger shape, with the two ends left flat.
 - Feed the two ends under the blanket stitching on top of the ornament.
 - Shape the wire ends into spirals.

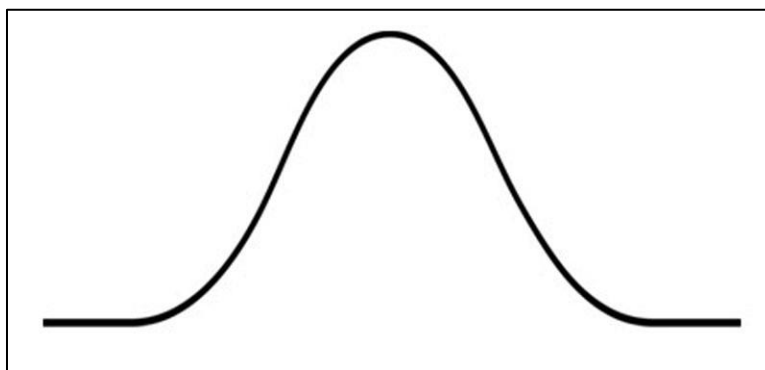
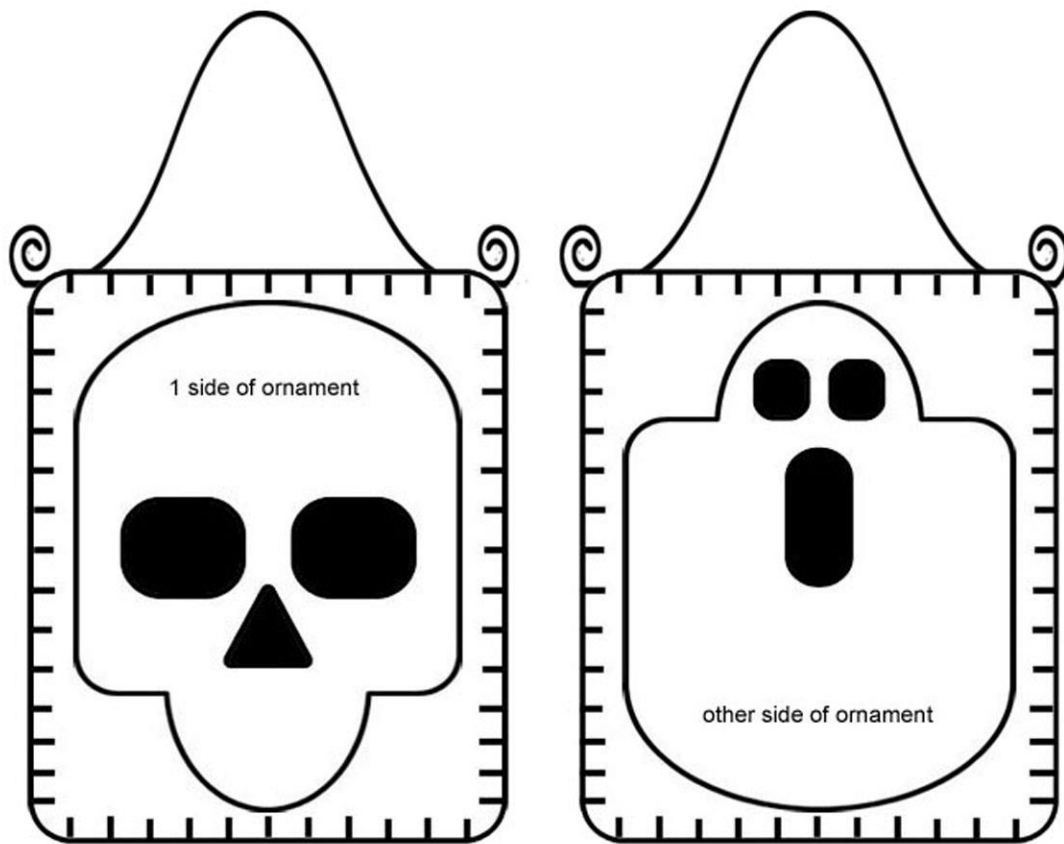
